## General Terms and Conditions of Booking for the 2012 Weston Lions Real Ale, Cider and Food Festival

- 1 Applications for bookings will be taken for the Food and Drink Festival, which accord with the Weston Lions mission statement. All exhibitors must operate from the County of Somerset. If spaces are available after the closing date the committee will consider other applications.
- 2 The deadline for applications for bookings is 1st April 2012. Applications may be accepted after this date but there is no guarantee that later bookings will be listed in the Festival publicity.
- 3 All applications for bookings must be accompanied by a cheque for the full payment for stall and equipment booked. The application form is not valid unless completed in full and signed. By signing the application form you agree to comply with these conditions. We regret refunds will not be given for bookings cancelled by exhibitors.
- 4 All applications for bookings will be considered by the Committee of The Weston Lions Real Ale, Cider and Food Festival, whose decision is final.
- 5 There will be overnight security on all nights when the Festival is set up. The organisers carry public liability insurance in respect of their own activities. All stallholders must have public and product liability insurance, and employer's liability insurance
- 6 Stallholders are responsible for provision of fire safety equipment on their stalls.
- 7 An officer of The Lions Club may inspect a stall at any time to ensure the safe and hygienic operation of the site and compliance with the conditions of booking and product descriptions before, during and after the Festival. Any directions given must be complied with immediately.
- 8 Stallholders undertake to comply fully with trading standards, health and safety, environmental health and all other relevant legislation. Stallholders are asked to keep their surrounding area as clean as possible throughout the time of the festival.
- 9 The Food and Drink Festival is open to the public each day from 11am and closes at 6pm on Friday and Saturday and at 5pm on Sunday,  
Stallholders may set up on the Thursday from 11am-7pm on the Friday 7am to 9am.  
All vehicles must be removed from the Beach Lawns after unloading. Please arrive in good time to be fully operational at 11am on Friday morning. No stall display is to be taken down before end of trading at 5pm on Sunday.
- 10 All electrical equipment must be certified and have a current PAT certificate. This certificate must be made available for inspection by our electrician at the Festival. Please note that non PAT tested equipment cannot be used under any circumstances. PAT testing is available on site at a cost of £15 per item.
- 11 Exhibitor toilets & hand wash facilities will be available on site, please ask where they are situated.
- 12 Facilities on site will be available for disposal of rubbish.

Please dispose of all waste and litter thoughtfully. Exhibitors will be liable for any damage they cause.
